Who is the Lay Director of Men's Walk #77?

Give us a quick introduction!

I am a retired Toledo Police Officer (33 years) and "Dad" to three outstanding young men. I had a near-death experience in 2016 which changed the focus of my life forever.

When and where was your original Walk? Share about that experience.

I was a Pilgrim in October, 2009 at Wesley UMC in Bryan, Ohio.

The whole walk was moving. Memorable moments for me include meeting my "new best friend" Jack Tibbets, all the hugs and seeing people I knew from church for Candlelight, and the Agape letters.

Why is Emmaus important to you:

In my career, I had the opportunity to see the worst of society. Through the Walk to Emmaus, I have been able to see the best of society. Here, I have encountered the loving and caring Body of Christ. I have had the opportunity to serve and witness the power of the Holy Spirit at work.

What is the Bible verse that you have chosen, and why?

Ecclesiastes 3:1, "To everything there is a season - and a time to every purpose under heaven". On the Monday following the most recent men's walk earlier this year, I was on my way work and the first song to randomly play was Turn, Turn, Turn by the Byrds. It struck me at that moment that a fall walk occurs in a season of change and the walk itself is a season of change in the pilgrims' lives.
